

- Possible flooding risk areas: These areas are expected to be flooded only as a result of extreme weather conditions, or a fault in the flood defense systems, like a dike burst
- Actual flooding risk areas: these areas have recently been flooded, or models demonstrate that they may be flooded once every century or more frequently
- Flooding risk zones: The federal government has demarcated flooding risk zones in view of the natural disasters insurance. Higher insurance fees apply for properties located in these flooding risk zones.
- Demarcated flooding area: In these zones, specific rules for expropriation, pre-emption, purchase and compensation obligations may apply.
- Demarcated riparian zone: For these zones, the Integrated Water Management decree imposes specific limitations of use.
